

SUPPORTING RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT IN THE NHS-INVITATION TO BID FOR TASK LINKED FUNDING FROM 2000/2001

Summary

- 1. This MEL provides details of the 2000/2001 bidding round for R&D Support Funding. It accompanies the "Invitation to Bid" document which addresses how to make a bid and what to include.
- 2. You will wish to note that the 'Invitation to Bid' is addressed to those seeking task-linked funding for no more than 3 years only.
- 3. Current Portfolio Agreements will remain in place until March 2002. Invitations to Bid for Portfolio Funding from April 2002 will be issued early in 2001.

Action

- 4. NHS Trusts and Practices wishing to bid for R&D Support Funding from 2000/2001 can submit an Expression of Interest to the Chief Scientist Office by Friday 30 April 1999. They will then have until Tuesday 31 August 1999 to make a final bid. Details are set out in the Invitation to Bid document. Submission of an Expression of Interest is mandatory if it is intended to make a final bid. Failure to do so will debar the bidder from the application process.
- 5. General Managers of Health Boards are requested to circulate this MEL to GPs; GDPs; Community Pharmacists and Optometrists within their area and to have a set of the documents placed in Board Libraries.


